PRINCIPAL'S REPORT Wednesday, 1 December 2021

Students returned to school from 8 November under a well structured return to school plan, compliant with NSW Health and Department of Education guidelines. All students returned to school on 15 November.

1. Acknowledgement of the valuable support and contributions of the NNPS P&C.
 - a. Through Peta the P& C have been a great support for the school in ensuring communications were a clear and well received by the community during the lock down period.
2. Student Leaders – The NNPS Student leaders managed the Everest of lost property. The student leaders sorted the clothing, produced class lists and ensured all lost property was well organised, ready for collection. The student leaders ran the lost property pick up point at the back gate very successfully. They displayed great organisational skills and confined in working with our parent community. Well done.
 - a. Lost Property follow up actions have been discussed with the second hand uniform shop.
3. Transition Day for Year 6 students going to NSHS went ahead on Tuesday, 23 November and was a great success.
4. School Improvement Plan (SIP): The SIP and annual reflections are a priority for the school. The School Senior Executive have commenced annual reflections to inform the strategic directions.
5. Projected numbers for 2022 are currently at 810 students. With this brings the need for an additional leaning space. The school in discussion with the DoE Infrastructure unit on this item.
6. IT hardware has been completed. A review of findings will be undertaken by the Senior Executive to position NNPS for 2022.
7. Staffing for 2022 is currently under way. Unfortunately, Gab Sutherland (sport) will not be with us next year. Sport will continue in 2022 under a new format.
8. Tree audit: the annual tree audit has been completed by the DoE. Work will be undertaken during the school holidays to ensure the school is safe from above.
9. New rugby league uniforms – NNPS will be obtaining quotes to update the current junior and senior rugby league playing kit for 2022.
