NNPS ATHLETICS CARNIVAL 2022

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

The Narrabeen North Public School Athletics Carnival is on **Tuesday, 26 July (Week 2, Term 3)** at the Sydney Academy of Sport, Narrabeen.

Please read all information carefully and return the note to your child's classroom teacher by Wednesday, 29 June (Week 10, Term 2). Please note your child will be unable to attend the carnival without returning their note.

Once again, Shot Put for Year 3 students has been completed at school with the top five boys and girls invited to compete with the other juniors from Years 4 and 5 at the carnival.

If your child wishes to compete in junior boys and girls long jump (8's, 9's and 10's) they will need to preenter via the permission note, and travel to the carnival by private transport, arriving at the Sydney Academy of Sport by 8.15am. No late entries will be admitted. High Jump will be run according to time available starting with the senior events.

TRAVEL

- Students will travel to and from the carnival by bus unless:
 - o **they are competing in 1500 metres** who will need to be there by **8:00am**. Parents will need to organise private transportation for these children.
 - they are competing in Junior Girls Long Jump and Junior Boys Long Jump (Juniors are students turning 8, 9 or 10 years of age this year) and need to be at the academy by 8:15am.
 Parents will need to organise private transportation for these children.
- Buses will leave the school by 9:15am and return by 2:45pm.
- Parents may take children home directly from the carnival; however, they must have filled in the note below and must also see a supervising teacher at the carnival to have the child's name marked off.

COST

• The cost was included on the Term 2 invoice. If you have not paid this, please do so.

COMPETITORS

- All students from Years 3 to 6 will attend.
- Year 2 students born in 2014 (turning 8 this year) may only enter track events.
- To enter the 1500 metre and field events (shot-put, high jump and long jump), all held on the day, the permission note below must be completed and returned by Wednesday, 29 June (Week 10, Term 2).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Students are to wear sports uniform, hat and sunscreen. Bring some warm clothing and a raincoat.
- No canteen facilities will be available. Students must bring their own recess and lunch.
- Students will sit in house areas; parents may join them in this area. Please stay away from OUT OF BOUNDS areas including the fence and hill please sit in the stands.
- Sunscreen should be applied REGULARLY to avoid sunburn. Please apply sunscreen before getting on the bus and throughout the day.
- Relays will only be held if time allows, depending on house numbers, and may not be a ribbon event.
- Not all events have finals in which case ribbon placing is based on times. Some events do have finals; in
 these cases winning a heat at the carnival does not indicate winning an event or being entitled to a
 ribbon. Please avoid taking your child from the carnival prior to the 100m finals being announced.
- All students will have their name marked off by their supervising teacher at the conclusion of the carnival.
- At the completion of the carnival, all participants will return to school by bus unless a parent is there to take them directly home.
- It is only in the case of extreme weather that the carnival will be called off. Should the Sydney
 Academy inform us the venue is closed a message will be sent via the school app and posted on
 the school website as soon as available.
