The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

The Narrabeen Education Campus project involves upgrades to Narrabeen North Public School and Narrabeen Sports High School.

At Narrabeen North Public School, the project will provide:

- new flexible permanent learning spaces
- upgraded learning spaces
- new supported learning spaces
- upgrades to core facilities, including the library, administration and hall.

At Narrabeen Sports High School, the project will provide:

- new and upgraded learning spaces
- upgraded supported learning spaces
- new amenities and refurbished gym
- upgraded sporting facilities.

Progress summary

We are finalising the concept design of the Narrabeen Education Campus in consultation with key stakeholders, including a Project Reference Group (PRG). The PRG includes representatives from the school communities including the Parents and Citizens Association (P&C), Principals and the Director of Educational Leadership, of both schools as well as architects, planners and design professionals.

We have been working with the PRG to refine the scope and concept design to provide the best outcome for the schools. The design of the schools will consider educational, operational and service delivery requirements. At this stage, we are not proceeding with the joint use arrangement with the Northern Beaches Council for specialist sporting facilities and we will retain the existing school hall at Narrabeen Sports High School.

Furthermore, more detailed site investigations and due diligence reporting have been completed to provide certainty on existing conditions and support our authority applications.

Next steps

- Schematic designs will be shared with the community in Term 3, 2022
- Statutory planning approvals including lodgement of a development application (DA) with Northern Beaches Council
- Tender a design and construct contract for the appointment of a builder.
